Known for textile mills and a thriving educational hub with numerous universities and colleges, Coimbatore boasts excellent connectivity by road, rail, and air, earning it a smart city status. HISTORY OF BHARATHIAR UNIVERSITY

Bharathiar University, established in 1982 in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, is named after the celebrated Tamil poet Subramania Bharathiar, affectionately known as Mahakavi Bharathiar. Founded under the Bharathiar Universities Act, 1981, the university received UGC recognition in 1985 and boasts an A++ accreditation from NAAC. Starting with a handful of departments in arts and sciences, it has grown to include over 40 academic departments offering postgraduate and PhD programs across diverse fields like science, humanities, commerce, management, and education. With more than 130 affiliated colleges and research institutions, the university offers a range of courses, including online and distance education. It also focuses on international collaborations, entrepreneurship development, and skill-based education, making it a leading educational hub. Bharathiar University's vision is to deliver globally benchmarked education that fosters character development, encapsulated in its motto 'Educate to Elevate.' The university strives for excellence in teaching, research, and knowledge dissemination while promoting inclusivity and innovation. By serving the nation's social, cultural, and economic needs, it aims to make a meaningful impact.

HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of History and Tourism, established in 2016, is a pioneering venture of Bharathiar University dedicated to advancing historical research. VENUE

The 32nd Annual Session of the Tamil Nadu History Congress will be held at Bharathiar University's sprawling 780-acre campus in Coimbatore. The venue is easily accessible by air, road, and rail. Coimbatore International Airport, with direct flights from across the country, is just 45 minutes away. Papers can be submitted in Tamil or English and should not exceed 10 pages, typed in double space on A4-sized paper with end-notes. An abstract of 150 words is required. Please submit two hard copies of your paper and abstract in MS Word format to the Local Organizing Secretary, Dr. R. DELEGATE FEE

All members of the Tamil Nadu History Congress, those intending to become members, and others interested in the proceedings are welcome to attend the 32nd Session. The **scholar/student delegates will be given our college women's hostel accommodation and men scholar/student delegates will be given dormitory type hostel accommodation. The scholar/student delegates ought to be certified by the HOD or Head of the Institution where they study.
