Instructions to Authors

- The author(s) wishes to publish his/her articles should not submit concurrent Research articles to any other journal.
- The author(s) should not submit any paper / article which has already been published in any of the Journal elsewhere.
- The author should make sure that the Research articles is original and not copied from any of the sources.
- Necessary and appropriate citations are to be mentioned in the articles under the reference head.
- The author should indicate explicitly all primary and secondary sources that have supported the research.
- The authors should ensure that all co-authors are acknowledged and all the co-authors have affirmed the final version of the paper.
- The articles published in the Journal are in a wide range of topics in Linguistics & Literature.
- It is ensured that the research articles processed for publication will be kept in a confidential and that no content of the research articles will be disclosed to anyone other than the corresponding author.
- All the research articles go under a double blind review.
- The plagiarism and AI-generated content in the research article must not exceed 20%. Articles exceeding this limit will not be accepted.
- Article in Tamil and English languages are accepted. (Tamil Article Arial Unicode font Must)

- A signed declaration from the author(s) stating the originality of the manuscript and confirming that it has not been published or submitted elsewhere.

- Strictly adhere to the instructions given, else article will be rejected.



Editorial Board

- The editors ensure that the author of the Research articles will be acknowledged within two days after submission. And ensure an efficient, fair and timely review process.
- The editors have the right to accept or reject a Research articles in terms of its significance, originality, clarity, its relevance to the journal.
- Editors will act if they suspect misconduct or if an allegation of misconduct is brought to them related to the publications of the articles. This duty extends to both published and unpublished papers.
- Editors will not simply reject papers that raise concerns about possible misconduct.
- Papers declined for publications due to reason such as copyright violations, repeated titles from the same author, etc., will not be considered in the future publications.
- Editors have the right to amend and emend the Research articles as well as have the right to publish or not to publish the articles.



Reviewers Instructions

- The reviewer is required to confirm the deadline for completion of the review and notify the editorial board in time.
- The reviewer should treat the Research articles in a confidential manner.
- Personal opinion and criticism of the reviewer is unacceptable.
- The reviewer should not use any part of the article for his or her own research.
- The reviewer should immediately notify the editor of any similarities between the Research articles under review and another paper either published or under consideration by any another journal.
