C. CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHEME (CAS) FOR UNIVERSITY TEACHERS

I. Assistant Professor (Academic Level 10) to Assistant Professor (Senior Scale/ Academic Level 11)

Eligibility:

- i) An Assistant Professor who has completed four years of service with a Ph.D. degree or five years of service with a M.Phil. / PG Degree in Professional Courses, such as LLM, M.Tech. M.V.Sc. and M.D., or six years of service in case of those without a Ph.D./M.Phil./PG Degree in a Professional course and satisfies the following conditions:
- ii) Attended one Orientation course of 21 days duration on teaching methodology;
- iii) Any one of the following: Completed Refresher/ Research Methodology Course/ Workshop/Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/Training Teaching-Learning-Evaluation, Technology Programmes/ Faculty Development Programmes of at least one week (5 days) duration, or taken one MOOCs course (with e certification) or development of e-contents in four-quadrants / MOOC's course during the assessment period; and
- iv) Published one research publication in the peer-reviewed journals or UGC-listed journals during assessment period.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- i) He/she gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of atleast three/four/five of the last four/five/six years of the assessment period as the case may be (as provided in Appendix, Table 1),and;
- ii) The promotion is recommended by the screening-cum evaluation committee.

II. Assistant Professor (Senior Scale/ Academic Level 11) to Assistant Professor (Selection Grade/ Academic Level 12)

Eligibility:

- i) Assistant Professors who has completed five years of service in Academic Level 11/ Senior Scale.
- ii) A Ph.D. Degree in the subject relevant/allied/relevant discipline.
- iii) Has done any two of the following in the last five years of Academic Level 11/ Senior Scale: Completed a course/programme from amongst the categories of Refresher Courses/ Research Methodology/ Workshops/Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/ Teaching-Learning-Evaluation/Technology Programmes/Faculty Development Programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration (or completed two courses of at least one week (five days) duration in lieu of every single course/ programme of atleast two weeks (ten days) duration), or, completed one MOOCs course in the relevant subject (with e-certification); or contribution towards the development of e-content in 4-quadrant (at least one quadrant) minimum of 10 modules of a course/ contribution towards the development of at least 10 modules of MOOCs course/ contribution towards conduct of a MOOCs course during the period of assessment.
- iv) Published three research papers in the peer-reviewed journals or UGC-listed journals during assessment period.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- i) The teacher gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' gradient he annual performance assessment reports of at least four of the last five years of the assessment period, (as prescribed in Appendix, Table 1) and;
- ii) The promotion is recommended by the Screening-cum-evaluation committee.

III. Assistant Professor (Selection Grade/ Academic Level 12) to Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A)

- i) Assistant Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 12/ Selection grade.
- ii) A Ph.D. Degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- iii) Anyone of the following during last three years: completed one course/ programme from amongst the categories of Refresher Courses/ Research Methodology Workshops/ Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/ Teaching-Learning-Evaluation Technology Programme/ Faculty Development Programme of at least two weeks (ten days) duration (or completed two courses of atleast one week (five days) duration in lieu of every single course/ programme of atleast two weeks (ten days) duration); or completed one MOOCs course (with e-certification); or contribution towards the development of e-content in 4-quadrant (atleast one quadrant) minimum of 10 modules of a course/ contribution towards development of atleast 10 modules of MOOCs course/ contribution towards conduct of a MOOCs course during the period of assessment.
- iv) A minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- v) Evidence of having guided atleast one Ph.D. candidate.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- i) He/she gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of atleast two of the last three years of the assessment period as specified in Appendix, Table 1, and has a research score of atleast 70 as per Appendix, Table 2.
- ii) The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with these Regulations.

IV. Associate Professor (Academic Level 13A) to Professor (Academic Level 14)**Eligibility:**

- i) An Associate Professor who has completed three years of service in Academic Level 13A.
- ii) A Ph.D. degree in the subject concerned/allied/relevant discipline.
- iii) A minimum of ten research publications in the peer- reviewed or UGC-listed journals out of which three research papers should have been published during the assessment period.
- iv) Evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- v) A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix, Table 2.

CAS Promotion Criteria:

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- i) He/she gets 'satisfactory' or 'good' grade in the annual performance assessment reports of atleast two of the last three years of the assessment period, as per Appendix, Table 1, and atleast 110 research score, as per Appendix, Table 2.
- ii) The promotion is recommended by a selection committee constituted in accordance with these Regulations.

EXAMPLE FOR CALCULATION OF ACTUAL SCORE

1. Assume that your total score of 1 to 6 = 2250

If your secured score (1 to 5a + 5c) = 750

and your secured Score of "Y" (5(b) +6) = 1500

However, "Y" should not exceed 30% of the total score

Then

$$\text{"Y"} = \frac{2250}{100} \times 30 = 675$$

Your score "Y" is 675

Your total Actual score is 750 + 675 = 1425

2. Assume that your total score of 1 to 6 = 2250

If your secured score (1 to 5 a + 5c) = 1950

and your secured Score of "Y" (5(b) +6) = 300

Total = 2250

Then

$$\text{"Y"} = \frac{2250}{100} \times 30 = 675$$

But, your score "Y" is 300 only.

Your total Actual score is 1950 + 300 = 2250
